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A comparison of major world inequality data sets: LIS, OECD, EU-SILC, WDI, ANDEHII

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Abstract

We present a comparison of coverage and values for five inequality data sets that have worldwide or major international coverage and independent measurements that are intended to present consistent coefficients that can be compared directly across countries and time. The comparison data sets are those published by the Luxembourg Income Studies (LIS), the OECD, the European Union's Statistics on Incomes and Living Conditions (EU-SILC), and the World Bank's World Development Indicators (WDI). The baseline comparison is with our own Estimated Household Income Inequality (EHII) data set of the
