



# UPDATE: Extinction Rebellion protests

## \*Further condition imposed, as of 21:00 hours, Monday, 14 October\*

On Monday, 14 October 2019, the Metropolitan Police Service imposed the following condition upon the ongoing Extinction Rebellion demonstrations in central London, under Section 14 of the Public Order Act 1986:

“Any **assembly** linked to the Extinction Rebellion ‘Autumn Uprising’...must now **cease** their **protest(s)** within London (Metropolitan Police Service, and City of London areas) by 2100hrs [on Monday] 14th October 2019.”

Protestors have been notified, and given an opportunity to **leave** the site. Anyone who fails to comply with the condition is liable for arrest and prosecution.

Deputy Assistant Commissioner Laurence Taylor said: “These conditions have been imposed due to the continued breaches of the section 14 condition previously implemented, and ongoing serious disruption to the community.

"Officers have begun the process of **clearing** Trafalgar Square and getting things back to normal.

"Today, protestors targeted areas in the City of London, causing further disruption to people and businesses in London's financial district. Police made more than 90 arrests.

"Since the beginning of this operation officers have been working hard to keep London moving. There have been more than 1,400 arrests, and a number of people have been charged. The policing operation continues, and we will continue to take action against anyone engaged in unlawful protests **at locations targeted by Extinction Rebellion.**"

### **Arrest update as of 17:00hrs on Monday, 14 October**

There have been 1,445 arrests in connection with the ongoing Extinction Rebellion protests across London.

### **Charges and arrests update as of 14:00 hours on Monday, 14 October**

A total of 76 people connected to the Extinction Rebellion protests have been charged with offences including failing to comply with a condition imposed under Section 14 of the Public Order Act 1986, criminal damage, and obstruction of a highway.

As of 14:00hrs a total of 1,405 people have been arrested in connection with the protests.

Eight individuals have been charged but have refused to provide police with their name. Anyone who has failed to provide their details is being remanded in custody to appear at court the next day.

The majority of those charged will appear at Westminster Magistrates' Court between 6 and 15 November. Others will appear at Camberwell and Thames Magistrates' Courts.

James Brown, 55 (08.10.1964) of Magdalen Road, Exeter was charged with causing a public nuisance in connection with an incident at London City Airport on Thursday, 10 October.

He appeared at Westminster Magistrates' Court on Saturday, 12 October for a first hearing. He will next appear at Southwark Crown Court on 8 November.

Those arrested but not charged have been released under investigation.

Of those charged, six have progressed through the courts. The following were charged with knowingly failing to comply with a condition imposed under Section 14 of the Public Order Act 1986:

Nicholas Harrison, DOB not given, of Spital View, Kendal, Cumbria - pleaded guilty and received a nine-month conditional discharge and was required to pay £85 costs and a £21 surcharge.

Angela Zelter, 68 (05.06.1951) of Church Street, Powys – pleaded guilty and was ordered to pay a £460 fine, £85 costs and £46 surcharge.

Vicky Hargreaves, 47 (03.05.1972) address unknown, was also charged with obstruction of a highway. She pleaded guilty and received a nine-month conditional discharge and was required to pay £85 costs and a £21 surcharge.

Hillary Hebron, 67 (17.05.1952) of Pittywood Road, Wirksworth, Matlock – pleaded guilty and received a four-month conditional discharge and was required to pay £50 costs and a £21 surcharge.

John Hill, 42 (24.12.1976) of Union Street, Sheffield – pleaded guilty and received a nine-month conditional discharge and was required to pay £85 costs and a £21 surcharge.

As of 20:00 on Thursday, 10 October, there have been 1,112 arrests in connection with the ongoing Extinction Rebellion protests across London.

#### **UPDATE at 1245hrs on Thursday 10 October**

Police are currently dealing with a number of protestors at City Airport in east London in connection with the Extinction Rebellion protests. One individual has been arrested on a flight on the runway and a number of people arrested outside the airport.

#### **DAC Laurence Taylor of the Metropolitan Police, said:**

"Our policing plan is aimed at preventing criminal activity which poses a significant safety and security risk to the airport, and the thousands of passengers using it. We are determined to deal with protestors robustly but proportionately.

"Targeting an airport and inconveniencing travellers in this way is wholly unacceptable and irresponsible. The consequences of committing offences at airports are serious; individuals breaking the law are being, and will continue to be, arrested and prosecuted where appropriate."

The following **condition** was imposed under Section 14 of the Public Order Act 1986:

"**Any assembly** linked to the Extinction Rebellion 'Autumn Uprising'...who wish to **continue with their assembly** MUST go to Trafalgar Square and **only assemble** in the pedestrianised area around Trafalgar Column."
